Caltrain Construction and Maintenance: March 6 - 15

Construction

Signal Optimization Project

Work on a \$2.8 million project to add [additional signals](#) to the Caltrain signal system will take place between the hours of 8 p.m., Monday, March 8 and 4 a.m., Tuesday, March 9 at Fair Oaks Lane in Atherton.

Grade Crossing Improvements

Caltrain will be reconstructing the pavement and track at three railroad crossings in the cities of Burlingame and San Mateo over the course of 10 weeks, beginning on Friday, March 12, 2010.

The work will go from north to south, beginning at Peninsula Avenue, then going to Villa Terrace and finally Bellevue Avenue. The intersections will be closed during the construction period. Electronic message boards will be used to direct traffic around the closed intersections.

For the reconstruction of Peninsula Avenue, the work will take place over the course of two full weekends. Work will go from 8 p.m. Friday, March 12 to 6 a.m. Monday, March 15, and again during the same times from Friday, March 19 to Monday, March 22. During that time, traffic will be diverted onto Anita Road, Bayswater Avenue and California Drive.

Neighbors may hear construction noise from concrete-cutting saws and jackhammers removing concrete, cranes lifting track panels, heavy equipment moving ballast and trucks placing asphalt. Portable light towers, powered by a diesel generator, also will be used for the work.

Maintenance

Caltrain will perform routine maintenance at several locations next week. To avoid delays to passengers, the work will take place Sunday through Thursday from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. There will be some construction noise from equipment used to accomplish the work, but crews will work as quietly as possible. San Francisco to Belmont

Sunday, March 7 to Thursday, March 11 crews will weld and repair switches on the tracks in between the San Francisco and Belmont stations.

Millbrae to San Mateo

Monday, March 8 to Thursday, March 11 crews will replace cross ties on the tracks between the Millbrae and Hayward Park stations.

Sunnyvale to San Jose

Sunday, March 7 crews will dump ballast along the tracks at various locations between Lawrence stations and San Jose Diridon stations. The ballast will be used for future maintenance projects.

Santa Clara to San Jose

Monday, March 8 to Thursday, March 11 crews will resurface the tracks between the Santa Clara and Tamien stations.

San Jose

Sunday, March 7 crews will replace switch ties on the tracks near the San Jose Diridon station.
