Sustainability Coordinator Kim provided a review of the Town’s Rain Barrel program in partnership with the Bay Area Water Supply and Conservation Agency (BAWSCA). City Manager Rodericks provided a few key takeaways from the event for improvement in future years that included installing signage before the day of the event, improved volunteer management and communication devices, improved traffic management related to entering the park, sharing event maps/layouts ahead of the event for all staff and volunteers, allot for more setup time for vendors, and improved vendor management from Town staff.
