| Days to Election | Date                              | Action or Deadline   |
|------------------|-----------------------------------|--|
| E-126            | July 5, 2016                      | Last scheduled City Council meeting prior to the measure deadline. City Council should consider and adopt resolution calling for an election, requesting consolidation, and include measure language, tax rate statement and full text.  |
| E-88             | August 12, 2016                   | Last day to submit resolution, ballot measure question, tax rate statement, and full text to the County Elections Official.  |
| E-88 - E -78     | August 12, 2016 - August 22, 2016 | Public review period (10 calendar days). Between these dates any registered voter eligible to vote on the contest in question may seek a writ of mandate or injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted if found to be misleading or inaccurate. |
| E-85             | August 15, 2016                   | City Clerk to publish a notice regarding measures, the dates for submitting primary arguments and rebuttals.   |
| E-82             | August 18, 2016                   | Randomized Alphabet Drawing conducted by County Elections Official at 11:00 a.m. to determine the letter that will be assigned to the measure.   |
| E-81             | August 19, 2016                   | Primary Arguments in favor of and against local measures are due by 5:00 p.m. Such arguments may be changed until and including today.   |
| E-81 - E-71      | August 19, 2016 - August 29, 2016 | Public review period (10 calendar days). Between these dates any registered voter eligible to vote on the contest in question may seek a writ of mandate or injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted if found to be misleading or inaccurate. |
| E-71             | August 29, 2016                   | Rebuttal Arguments for measures where a primary argument was filed both in favor and against are due on this date by 5:00 p.m. Such arguments may be changed until and including today.  |
| E-71             | August 29, 2016                   | Impartial Analyses for measures are due on this date by 5:00 p.m.  |

| E-71 - E-61 | August 29, 2016 - September 8, 2016   | Public review period (10 calendar days). Between these dates any registered voter eligible to vote on the contest in question may seek a writ of mandate or injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted if found to be misleading or inaccurate. |
| E-40 - E-21 | September 29, 2016 - October 18, 2016 | Between these dates, the San Mateo County Sample Ballot and Official Voter Information Pamphlet will be mailed to each voter who is registered at least 29 days prior to the election.   |
| E-29 - E-7  | October 10, 2016 - November 1, 2016   | Between these dates, vote by mail ballots will be sent to all registered voters who are permanent vote by mail voters or who requested a vote by mail ballot for this election.  |
| E-0         | November 8, 2016                      | Election Day   |
| E+3         | November 11, 2016                     | Last day for County Elections Office to accept vote by mail ballots that are postmarked on Election Day.   |
| E+30        | December 8, 2016                      | Last day for County Elections Office to certify election results to the jurisdictions participating in the election.   |
