Dear Neighbor:

California Water Service (Cal Water) is pleased to inform you of an upcoming water infrastructure upgrade that will improve water supply reliability for our customers in the Town of Atherton. Almost ninety percent of the water we supply to your neighborhood is purchased surface water from the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, and we are planning to construct an additional water storage tank for use in emergencies such as natural disasters and power or water outages.

We intend to build a 3.0 million-gallon, pre-stressed concrete tank at our existing Cal Water station, located at **120, Reservoir Road, Atherton, CA 94027**. The new storage tank would be 34 feet tall and 158 feet in diameter, and painted the same color to match the existing tanks onsite. Additionally, the tank would be designed and constructed in accordance with American Water Works Association and California state seismic standards.

We invite you to come learn more about this proposed project at a community presentation on **Thursday, February 9, 2017** from **6-7 pm** at our **Reservoir Road station**. This meeting will enable residents to learn more about the infrastructure improvement project, and get any questions you may have answered.

After this meeting, we will follow up on our project application with the Town of Atherton. We will also send a notice to all property owners within 500 feet of this station at least 10 days prior to the Town's hearing to review this application.
