# City council OKs deal for stoplight

The Atherton City Council agreed to an arrangement with the Las Lomas School District to build a water retention basin at a school in return for money and a stoplight.

At its meeting on Wednesday, council reviewed its agreement with the school district and approved it, according to City Manager George Rodericks.

In return for a water retention basin to be built at Las Lomas School at 299

Alameda de las Pulgas, the town will look into installing a stoplight at Walsh Road and Alameda de las Pulgas.

Rodericks said council wants to hear from residents about the stoplight and wants to further study the stoplight placement. Roderick estimates that both the basin and the stoplight's construction will be completed by summer 2019. The town will also pay the district \$500,000 over five years for the basin and will be responsible for maintenance to it.
