# Parcel tax on ballot

Atherton voters in November will decide whether to extend an approximately \$750 parcel tax by three years.

Atherton Town Council voted on Wednesday to place the parcel tax extension on the ballot. The current tax is set to expire next year.

The tax brings in about \$1.86

million a year and is used for street repairs and police services, according to City Manager George Rodericks. The tax will appear on the Nov. 7 ballot and requires a two-thirds majority to be approved.
